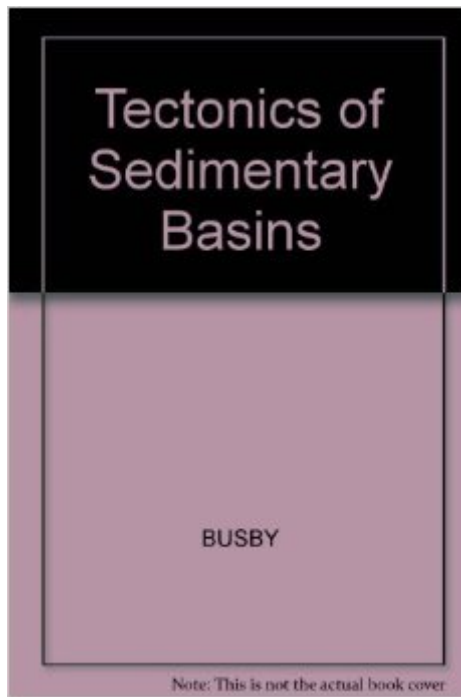


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Synopsis

This upper-level textbook relates the theory of plate tectonics, which revolutionized geology 20 years ago, to the study of sedimentation. Sedimentary basins are characterized by their position relative to the plate margin when deposition occurs, and each chapter in this book examines a different major basin type. This book should be useful for sedimentology students and researchers alike.

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
